Lies & Rationalizations:

“I’m just a physical person.”

“Everyone struggles in one area or another.
This just happens to be the area in which
I struggle.”

Lies & Rationalizations:

“Guys just want to have sex so they can brag to their friends that they ‘hit it.’”

“For guys, sex is just a physical act that is unconnected with their feelings.”

Lies & Rationalizations:

“Unless there is penetration, it is not sex.”

“I am still a virgin if we have never actually
‘done it.’”

“Oral sex does not count as sex.”

“Experimenting with friends is not sex.”

Lies & Rationalizations:

“Lust is a sin, and all sins are equal.
At least if I act on my impulses,
and take care of my lustful thoughts,
I will be sinning less, not more.”

“Jesus forgives all sins. I am so good
in other areas, I am sure that He
will easily forgive these sins.”

Lies & Rationalizations:

“God created us to be sexual beings.
I am just acting the way God made me.”

“If He didn’t want us to have sex,
He wouldn’t have made us so sexual.”

Lies & Rationalizations:

“Fornication really refers to immoral sex, or illicit sex, or sex without love. We are in love, so sex is allowable (or at least less offensive).”

“God knows that we are going to get married, so I sure He understands.”

The Truth

1 Peter 1:13-16

“Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed. As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: “Be holy, because I am holy.”

The Truth

Ephesians 5:3-4

“But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God’s holy people. Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving.”

The Truth

2 Corinthians 5:17-18a

“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation, the old has gone, the new has come! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.”

The Truth

Hebrews 10:22-24

“Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another – and all the more as you see the Day approaching.”

The Truth

Hebrews 10:26-31

“If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left, but only a fearful expectation of judgment and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God. . . . How much more severely do you think a man deserves to be punished who has trampled the Son of God under foot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified him, and who has insulted the spirit of grace? . . . It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.”


