## DOES PRAYER CHANGE GOD'S MIND?



#### Consensus:

It is likely that God can "change His mind."

This seems to mostly result from our wrestling with God.

We can never really know the mind of God, so our best course of action (and the one commanded in Scripture) is to pray as if we can change God's mind.

#### Consensus:

God invites prayer, even as we pray "thy will be done."

At times, God appears to restrict His sovereignty to allow us to exercise our free will.

Other times, He intervenes in the natural order to compel a result.

Since we cannot know which will occur in any single circumstance, our best course of action is to pray.

WHY PRAY IF GOD ALREADY KNOWS ALL OF YOUR NEEDS?



#### Consensus:

Assurance that God knows our needs does not make prayer pointless, it actually makes it more meaningful.

Jesus commands prayer despite the Father knowing our needs.

Jesus modeled prayer for reasons other than petitioning God.

Jesus commended persistent and insistent prayer well after our needs were made known.

#### "Axioms" of Prayer:

If your prayer is not answered, it is because you lack the faith.

True miracles of physical healing occur every day; God wants you to be healed and is waiting for you to ask.

The prayers of a righteous person carry more weight with God. If you are righteous, and doing His will, your prayer will be answered.

DOES PRAYER *ONLY* CHANGE US, OR DOES IT ALSO CHANGE THE WORLD?



#### "Axioms" of Prayer:

The more people pray for a certain result, the more likely it is for God to grant that request (praying in agreement).

Some people have the "gift of intercession" which means they have a spiritual gift whereby God listens more to their prayer for others.

#### Philip Yancey:

Jesus could have said something like this: "I am bestowing the gift of prayer. You must realize, of course, that humans cannot have perfect wisdom, so there are limits as to whether your prayers will be answered. Prayer operates like a suggestion box. Spell out your requests clearly to God, and I guarantee that all requests will be carefully considered."

DOQS THE GIFT OF

The gift of intercession is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the Body of Christ to pray for extended period of time on a regular basis and see frequent and specific answers to their prayers, to a degree much greater than that which is expected of the average Christian.
