THE POWER OF PRHYER

IF YOUR PRAYER
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- 1. Your prayer may not be answered because it is against God's sovereign will.
 - I John 5:14: "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us."
- 2. Your prayer may not be answered because it is against God's moral will.
 - I John 3:22: "And whatever we ask we receive from Him because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleading in His sight."

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3. Your prayer may not be answered because you are not abiding in Christ.

John 15:7: "If you abide in me, and My words in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done."

4. Your prayer may not be answered because of sin.

1 Peter 3:12: "For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and His ears are open to their prayers; But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil." (citing Psalm 34:12-16)

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5. Your prayer may not be answered because of improper motives.

James 4:3 "When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures."

6. Your prayer may not be answered because of issues of forgiveness

Mark 11:25: "And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you."

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And finally ...

7. Your prayer may not be answered because you lack faith.

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Faith that God can make it happen (God's power), vs. faith that what you pray for will happen (certainty)

THE POWER OF PRAYER WHY WONT GOD HEAL AMPUTEES?



CHRISTIAN RESPONSES.

- 1. Jesus was speaking with the Apostles; miracles have ceased since the time of the Apostles.
- 2. Prayer is for strength to deal with the situation, not to change it.
- 3. We don't know that God has never healed an amputee; just because we don't know of such an instance doesn't mean it has never happened.
- That would be too obvious a show of God's power, and it would destroy our ability to have faith.
- Prosthetics evidence God's provision and love for us.
- Am amputation is a medical procedure, not something that requires healing. (It was the healing.)
- People born without limbs are born for the Glory of God (John 9).

THE POWER OF PRAYER WHY WONT GOD HEAL AMPUTEES?



The Question Assumes:

- 1. God's love, goodness and mercy require Him to heal everyone.
- 2. God is bound by (subservient) to our prayers.
- 3. God's promises are limited to this life, and that our future life with Him cannot qualify as an answer our prayers.
- 4. Miracles occur with the same frequency as they did in other periods described in scripture.

THE POWER OF PRHYER WHY WONT GOD HEAL AMPUTEES?



The Question Highlights:

- 1. Miracles may occur with much less frequency that we imagine.
- 2. God may act much more often through His providence than through acts which contravene His natural order.
- 3. God chooses to partner with us. He may choose not to act in areas where we can/should act in His name (for His purposes).
- 4. We may not understand the nature and quality of life lived in the midst of a fallen existence (consequences of sin and suffering).

THE POWER OF PRAYER WHY WONT GOD HEAL AMPUTEES?



Question Yourself:

- 1. Am I expecting a miracle as an entitlement?
- 2. Am I using the benefits of God's common grace and providence, such as our body's ability to heal itself or medical knowledge?
- 3. Do I wrongly blame God for causing suffering?
- 4. Can I accept that physical healing may not take place?
