### Some Definitions

Free Will: Some ability to choose to obey the Lord or do evil.

#### Contrast:

- Free will must be entirely free.
- If God has any control over anything, there is no free will in the matter.
- If any thing or any one or any circumstance has influence over the situation, then I do not have free will.

### Some Definitions

Free Will: Some ability to choose to obey the Lord or do evil.

Evil:

Rebellion against God; not doing what God commands, or doing what God forbids.

#### Contrast:

- Knowledge or experience of evil is needed to know good.
- Our sense of right and wrong defines evil.

Could God have created a world in which there was no evil?

Yes,

Could God have made a world inhabited by beings with the power to choose good or evil in which no one would ever have made the wrong choice?

Could God have made a world inhabited by beings with the ability to choose good or evil in which no one was given the ability to make the wrong choice?

Could God have created a better world that allows us to exercise free will and make wrong choices, but without evil and suffering resulting?

No. "

If God "knew" that humans would sin, resulting in evil and suffering, why did He create us?



Christian:

God gave us free will so that we could love Him. He loved us first, and our free will allows us to choose to love Him in return.

Response:

Free will resulted in evil, which resulted in death and suffering to every person who has ever lived.

After death, most people will end up suffering in hell for eternity. All this so we can freely love Him?

Consider:

If we need free will to love God, and free will is not free unless we can choose to sin, how will we love God in heaven?

"Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes.

There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain,
for the old order of things has passed away."

Revelation 21:3b-4

Could God have created a better world that allows us to exercise free will and make wrong choices, but without evil and suffering resulting?

No. \*

If God "knew" that humans would sin, resulting in evil and suffering, why did He create us?

If God "knew" that humans would sin, is He responsible for the evil and suffering which results since He went ahead and created us?

#### Some Observations

Allowing for the possibility of sin, in the midst of God's express prohibition of sin, does not make God culpable of sin.

God is the source of all good, and all good comes from God.

God is Holy, pure and blameless. He cannot be the author, cause or source of evil.

But God must be said to allow evil. Otherwise, we conclude that evil is beyond God's sovereign power.
