Responses to Suffering Resulting From Natural Disasters

- 1. God has created the world to operate within certain laws of nature.
- 2. The <u>earth is under a curse</u>, so that the very laws of nature have been tainted by sin, leading to natural disasters and suffering.
- 3. Our free will plays a role in natural disasters.
- 4. Sometimes God uses natural disasters to punish evil.
- 5. Sometimes <u>Satan</u> is allowed to inflict suffering through natural disasters.
- 6. God sends natural disasters to turn His people back to Him.
- 7. Other explanations:
 - Disaster leads to self-examination of our own mortality
 - Disaster can bring out the best in people
 - Disaster can lead to spiritual renewal
 - Disaster shapes our character

If some disasters simply occur in nature, why doesn't God do more to prevent such widespread death, destruction and suffering?





Suffering Results From God's Discipline In Our Lives

"In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. And you have forgotten that word of encouragement that addresses you as sons:

"My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, 6because the Lord disciplines those he loves, and he punishes everyone he accepts as a son."

"Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as sons.
For what son is not disciplined by his father? If you are not disciplined
(and everyone undergoes discipline), then you are illegitimate children and not true
sons. Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us and we respected
them for it. How much more should we submit to the Father of our spirits and live!
Our fathers disciplined us for a little while as they thought best;
but God disciplines us for our good, that we may share in his holiness.
No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a
harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.
(Hebrews 12:4-11)


You say, 'I am rich; I have acquired wealth and do not need a thing.'








God Allows Suffering To Better Sympathize With Others
