The Steely Spirit What Would Your Life Look Like?

"Even our church growth can happen without Him.

Let's be honest: if you combine a charismatic speaker, a talented worship band, and some hip, creative events, people will attend your church. Yet this does not mean that the Holy Spirit of God is actively working and moving in the lives of the people who are coming. ...

People are more likely to describe the quality of the music or the appeal of the sermon than the One who is the reason people gather for "church" in the first place."



The Stoly Spirit What Would Your Life Look Like?

GOD WOULD BE CLEARLY EVIDENT

"When I live by my own power and strength, relying solely on my natural talents to see me through, then people naturally praise me for how I am living. But when I am living in a way that requires me to depend on the Holy Spirit, people respond by praising my Father in heaven."



The Stoly Spirit What Would Your Life Look Like?

SPIRITUAL FRUIT IS PRODUCED BEYOND MEASURE

"Do you possess [the fruit of the Spirit] to a supernatural degree? Do you exhibit more kindness and faithfulness than the Mormons you know? Do you have more self-control than your Muslim friends? More peace than Buddhists? More joy than atheists? ... What disturbs me most is that we're not really bothered that God living in us has not made much of a noticeable difference. Most churghgoers are content to find a little bit of peace rather than a "peace of God, which surpasses all understanding."

EXAMPLES FROM THE LIVES OF THE APOSTLES

Sudden, brilliant awareness of God actually being present.

Unexplainable joy in the midst of suffering.

The power of their words and their preaching to penetrate.

Transformed from asking questions, to having answers.

They freely delighted in prayer, from those who could not stay awake during prayer to those who prayed at all hours.

They passionately loved the Scriptures and had new insights into their focal point: Christ.
