Why Study Idolatry?

- ▶ We all worship something or someone other than God.
- ▶ Our worship of people and things does not involve graven images, but it is idolatry nonetheless.
- ▶ Worship of idols is not only a matter of loving something or someone *more* than God; it is often the case that we also love God *less*.
- ▶ The First Command, in both the Old and New Testament, is to love God with all of your heart, soul, strength and mind.
