"But now I am writing to you that you must not associate with anyone who claims to be a brother or sister but is sexually immoral or greedy, an idolater or slanderer, a drunkard or swindler. Do not even eat with such people."

- Are you disappointed when you have just bought something, and a better version comes out a few weeks later?
- Do you feel strange when you buy something, and a friend buys the same thing? Or a better thing?






- Do you get upset when something you own gets damaged, breaks, or wears out?

- Do you give away enough of your income that you are often stretching your ability to give that much away?


