Starting Point...

- ▶ Our desire to love others, and to be loved by them, is hard-wired into the way in which we were created.
- ▶ Being created in the image of God means, in part, that we were created for relationship.
- ▶ But like many things tainted by the fall, we are tempted to replace the Creator with what has been created.
(Romans 1:25-27)

Genesis 2:20-24

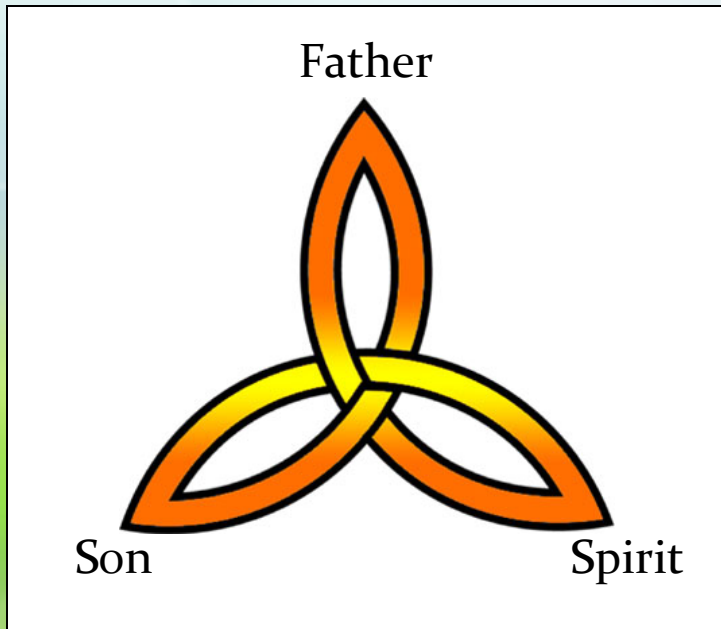

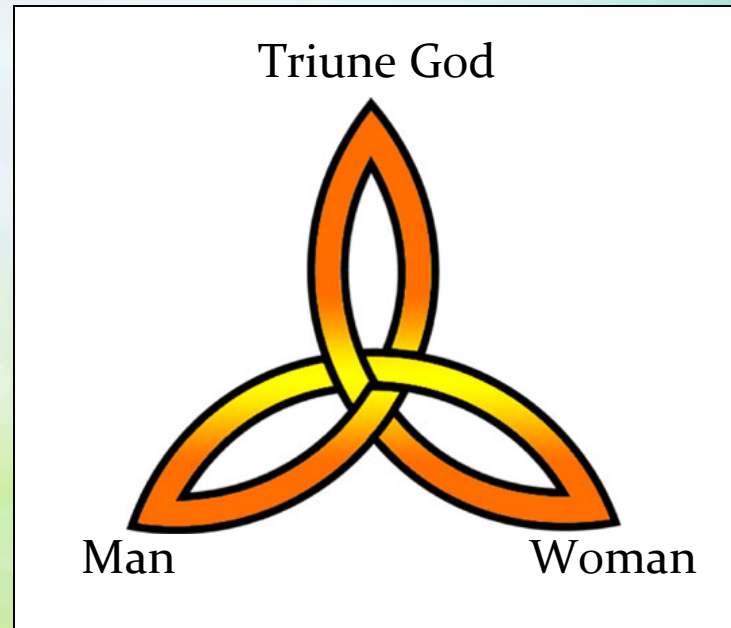
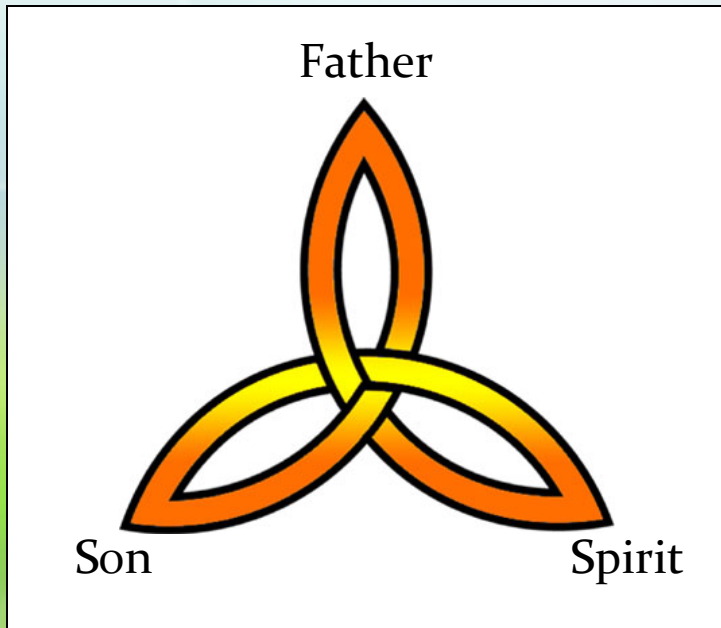

Do You Worship Love?

Romans 1:21-25

“For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened. Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images made to look like a mortal human being and birds and animals and reptiles.

Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another. They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen.”

Romans 1:26-27

“Because of this, God gave them over to shameful lusts. Even their women exchanged natural sexual relations for unnatural ones. In the same way the men also abandoned natural relations with women and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed shameful acts with other men, and received in themselves the due penalty for their error.”

Love & Sensuality as Societal Idols

- ▶ The abundance of Christian literature on singleness and finding a mate.
- ▶ The objectification of men, women and sexual imagery.
- ▶ The prevalence, use and acceptance of pornography.
- ▶ The difficulty of getting couples and married people to develop deep relationships with others.
- ▶ The fact that many married people report a decrease in sexual activity in marriage.

Recovering Love: 1 Cor. 13:4-7

“Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.”

- ▶ Do you spend time hoping or imagining a greater sense of fulfillment in your life that might come from being in a relationship?

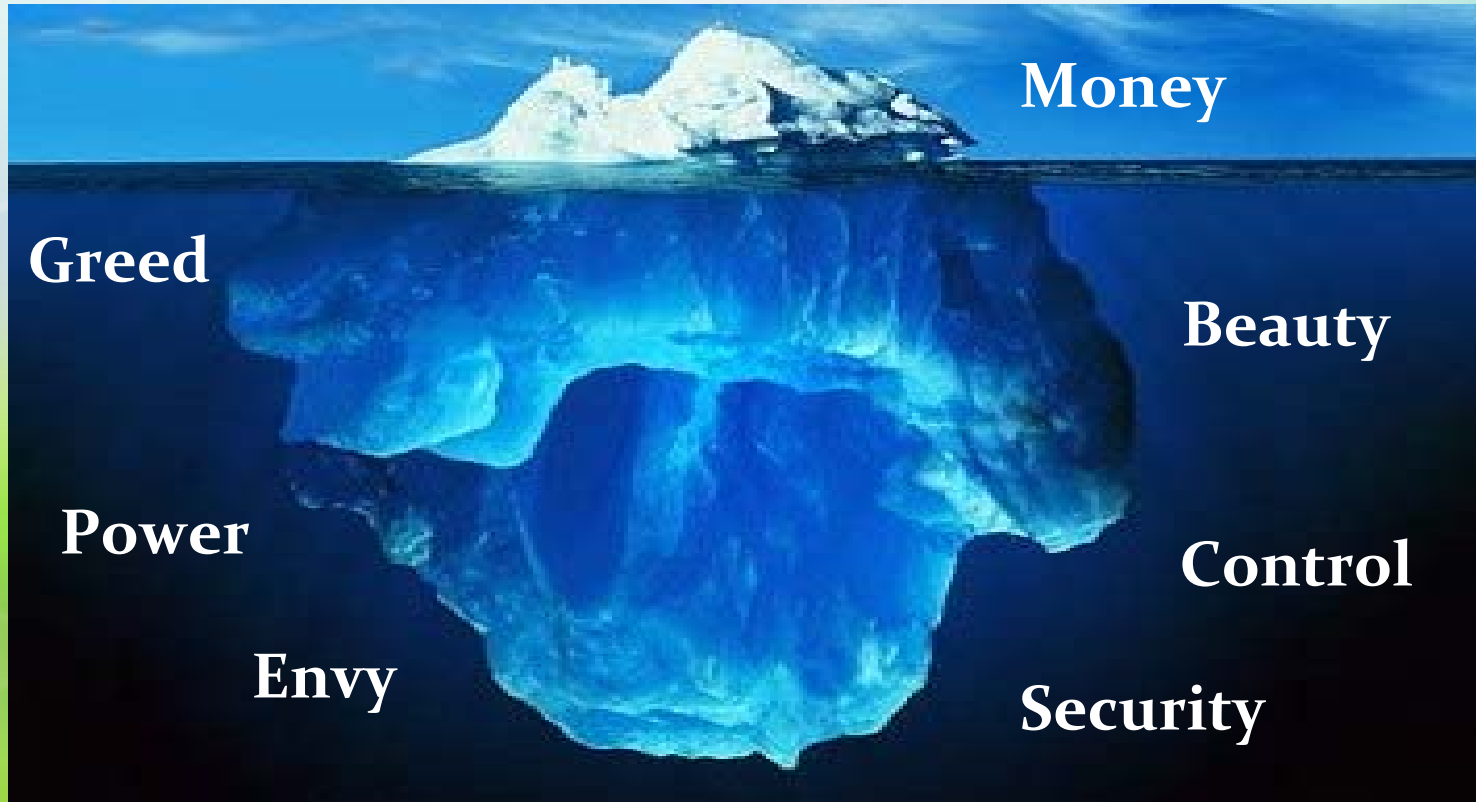
Angry: Examine Your Heart

- ▶ Are you angry towards God for unmet relational needs? Are you angry at others because of unmet relational needs?
- ▶ Regardless of your intent, does your anger have the effect of increasing the amount you are cut off from God and others? Is your anger increasing?
- ▶ Have you had ongoing difficulty in getting over broken relationships and forgiving the other person?
- ▶ Have you had such difficulty with relationships that you have sworn them off entirely?

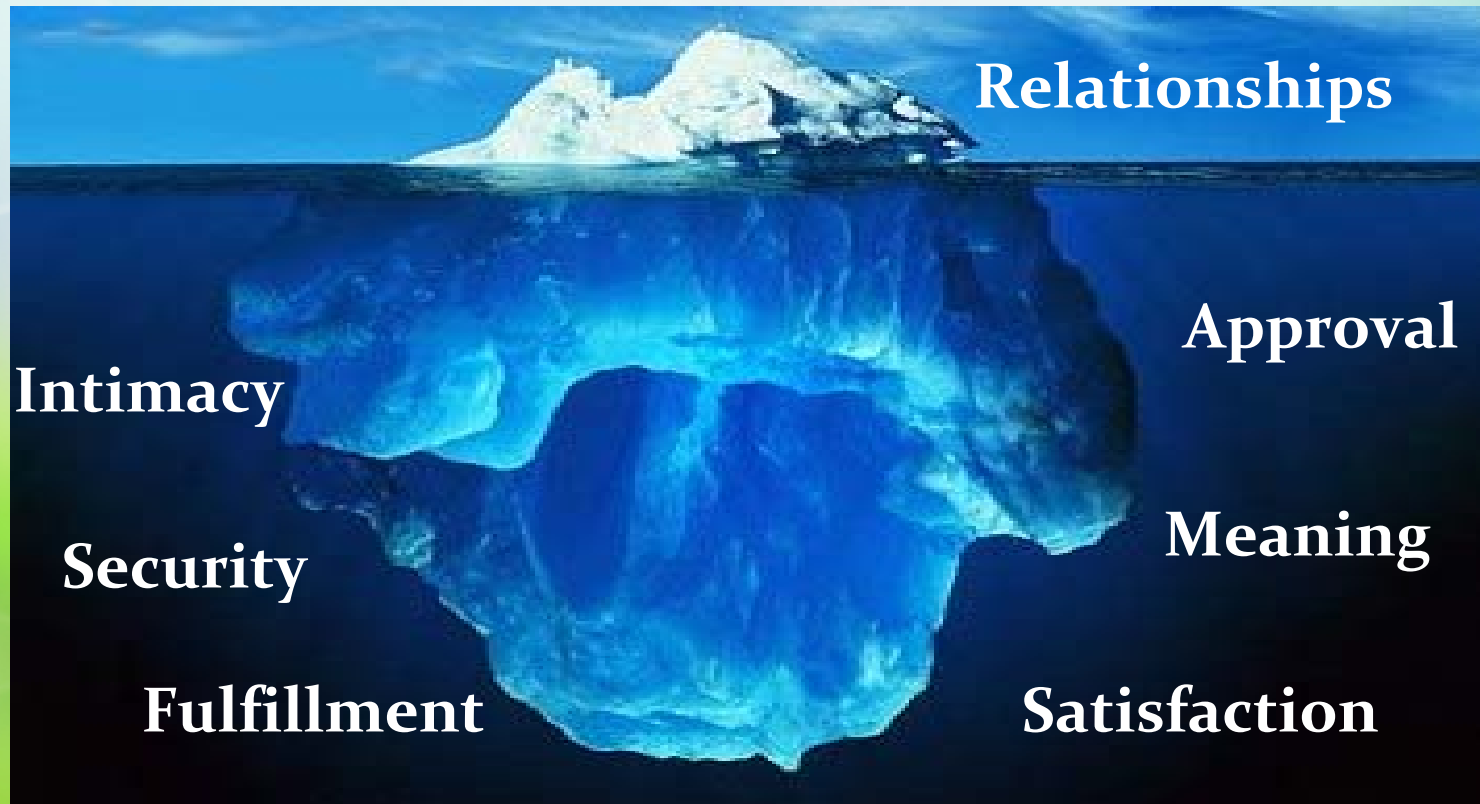

Genesis 29:26-28

She conceived again, and when she gave birth to a son she said, ‘Because the Lord heard that I am not loved, he gave me this one too.’ So she named him Simeon.

She conceived again, and when she gave birth to a son she said, ‘This time I will praise the Lord.’ So she named him Judah. Then she stopped having children.”
