



And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified. ... Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies." - Romans 8:29-30, 33

"And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory." - Ephesians 1:13b-14

"For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy. ... And where these [sins] have been forgiven, sacrifice for sin is no longer necessary." - Hebrews 10:14, 18

Verses Supporting Loss by Apostasy

"It is impossible for those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, who have shared in the Holy Spirit, who have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the coming age and who have fallen away, to be brought back to repentance. To their loss they are crucifying the Son of God all over again and subjecting him to public disgrace." - Hebrews 6:4-8

"If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left, but only a fearful expectation of judgment and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God. Anyone who rejected the law of Moses died without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. How much more severely do you think someone deserves to be punished who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified them, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace? ... You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised." - Hebrews 10:26-29; 36




Verses Supporting Loss by Apostasy

SOVEREIGNTY

SOVEREIGNTY

If God has sovereign control while allowing for human contingency;

GRACE


If grace remains unmerited favor even if humans can resist or reject it;
