"If few people make it to heaven (Luke 13:23-24), how do we know if we are saved?"

 - Do we have a genuine desire for relationship with Jesus?
 - Do we evidence strong obedience to God's commands?

"How does Jesus' death actually take care of sin? Why does God require sacrifice for reconciliation?"

"Did something literally happen (physically or metaphysically) when Christ died, or was it symbolic?"

"In scripture, there seems to be descriptions of salvation that have eternal implications, while other times it refers to deliverance from a specific situation. Is there a way to differentiate?"

"Can those who have never heard the name "Jesus" still be saved?"

"If salvation is through faith / relationship with Jesus, what about all the people before Jesus' time on earth?"



"What about the fact that we are not on a "level playing field" when it comes to our understanding of salvation, especially with regard to our personal and environmental differences?"

"It seems there is a geographical bias to salvation. If you live in the US, or even in North/South America, you have a better chance of hearing about Jesus than if you lived in another part of the world. How does that relate to election, or does it?"

"How do we move past a Westernized understanding of salvation? For example, the "Jesus Prayer" is a very Western-style formula for bringing some to salvation. Does this have to do more with evangelism?"



"How do you help a new believer know or experience assurance of Christ's presence in their life?"

"What's the most basic "formula" for salvation, and then what is the biblical mandate for doing/being/believing anything further?"


"If I didn't understand all this "stuff" when I accepted Christ when I was 4, does that make me less saved?"





