### What Did We Do ... and Why?

"Still, after studying the role of faith communities and families in spiritual formation, I believe that the problem is not only the next generation's short attention span, exhibitionism, or lack of intellectual rigor. Rather, I think faith communities have not done a good job creating environments and experiences where students can process their doubts. Our posture towards students and young adults should be more Socratic, more process-oriented, more willing to live with their questions and seek answers together. We need guides who know how to strike a better balance between talking and listening."

### What Did We Do ... and Why?

"Virtually the first thing every single person I talked to said is that they wish church weren't just a sermon but a discussion. They uniformly expressed that they do not want to only sit and listen to a preacher giving a lecture. And it's not because they don't want to learn. They expressed a strong desire to learn the teachings of Jesus and to learn about the Bible. Rather, they feel they can learn better if they can participate and ask questions."
